Out Of 624 Male Career Firefighters Nationwide, Around **7%** Met The Criteria for Current PTSD Assessed by the PCL-C.

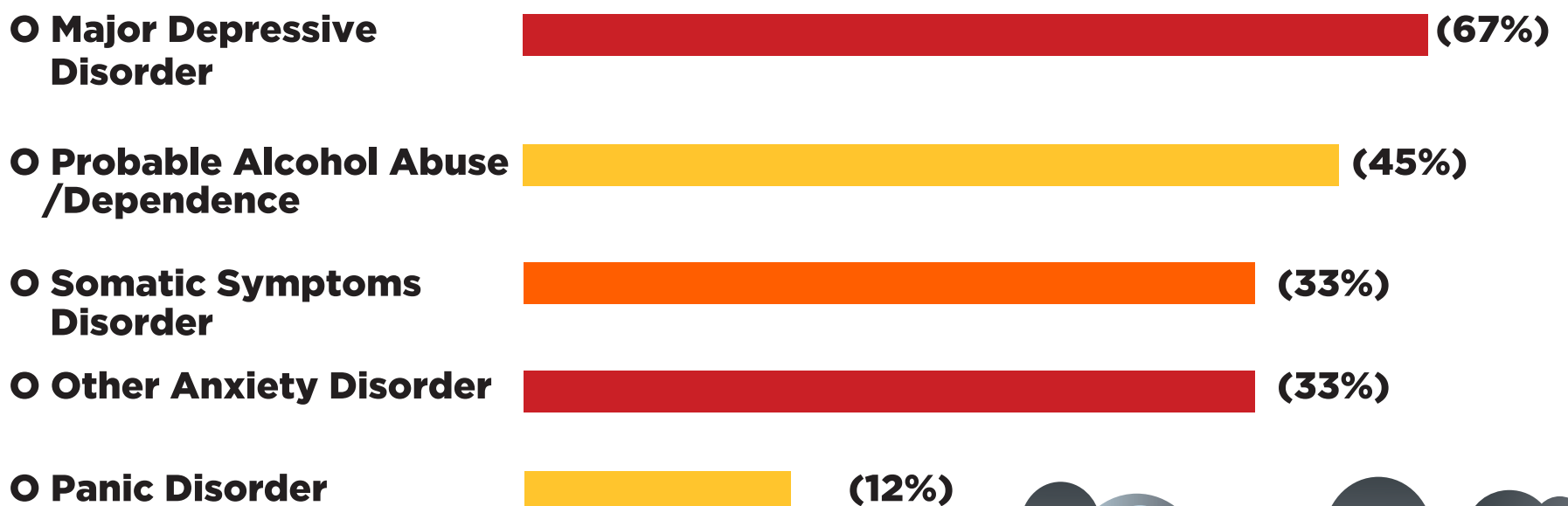

Approximately **87%** of firefighters with PTSD screened positive for at least one mental health conditions.

Firefighters with PTSD were more likely to have higher numbers of simultaneously present mental health issues when compared to those who did not diagnose with PTSD.

OCCUPATIONAL OUTCOMES

Firefighters Who Screened Positive For PTSD Reported Having:

- ↑ Higher Occupational Stress
- ↑ Higher Duty-related Incident Stress
- ↓ Lower Perception of Their Self-efficacy to Manage Stress or Trauma Exposure
- ↓ Lower Perception of Support from Their Fire Department

JOB SATISFACTION

Firefighters with PTSD:

- ☹ Were Not Optimistic about Their Future Success
- ☹ Were Not Satisfied with Their Job in Their Department
- ☹ Less Likely to Recommend a Career in the Fire Service to Others
